The following are general areas of study this week:

- **Math:** Kindergarten will do adding. Second grade is working with fractions. Fourth grade will continue with fractions. Fifth grade is learning integers. Seventh grade will review the rest of the year. Eighth grade will review the rest of the year.
- **Christ Light:** Kindergarten is studying Job and second and fourth grade are studying Hezekiah.
- **Reading:** Second grade will read about a Mexican family. Fourth and fifth grade will continue doing research papers on disasters. Seventh and eighth grade will read "Anne Frank: The Diary of a Young Girl."
- **Music:** None
